RULES.

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing**.
- 1.2. State law requires a USCG approved PFD for each person on board and a throwable cushion.
- 1.3. A protest flag must be displayed as a protest requirement. (This modifies RRS 61.1 (a))

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.

- 2.1. The Regatta is open to all Interlakes. Enter by completing the Entry Form and submitting it along with the registration fee.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

- 4.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on Saturday morning.

5. VENUE.

- 5.1. Portage Yacht Club, on Portage Lake, is 14 miles northwest of Ann Arbor at 8900 Dexter-Pinckney Rd., Pinckney, Michigan 48169. See www.ms-pyc.com for information on the Club, a map, and a link to current weather conditions.

6. THE COURSES.

- 6.1. Races will be sailed around movable buoys set in triangular or windward-leeward configurations.
- 6.2. Up to five races are possible.

7. Scoring

- 7.1. Point Scoring of Appendix A shall apply except that a boat's series will be the total of her race scores, and first place finishes shall be scored as 0.75 points. (This modifies RRS A4.)
- 7.2. One race will constitute a series.
- 7.3. Prizes will be awarded for the first three place finishes.

8. BOAT LAUNCHING.

- 8.1. Tilt trailers are recommended. For non-tilt trailers or boats with full boat covers, a boat hoist and tilt trailer will be provided to facilitate launching.

9. FAMILY AND SPECTATORS.

- 9.1. Family and guests of competitors are welcome to attend and use the Portage Yacht Club facilities during the regatta, including showers as well as the upper deck, which provides an excellent view of the racing area. No pets allowed.

VENUE NOTES

Invitational Regatta Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.

PYC is a tobacco free premises.

Smokers must discard smoking materials in an appropriate receptacle, NOT on the ground.

MINIMUM attire inside the Clubhouse is T-Shirt over bathing suit and sandals, even when just going to the restrooms.

Boats shall keep out of the Club swimming area and other swimming areas around the shore of Portage Lake. Boats should avoid passing between swimming docks and the nearby shoreline.

Rigging Buoys are to be used for raising and lowering sails only.

Sailboats are not to be tied to the docks.

The Michigan Liquor Control Commission dictates that members and guests may not bring alcoholic beverages into the Clubhouse or onto the attached decks. In addition, members and guests may not take alcoholic beverages purchased from the Club from the Clubhouse or decks to any other area.

The PARK ROOM and LOWER DECK are our primary food service areas. Members and guests are not to bring personal food or beverages into these areas.

The CDC amended their masking recommendation exemption to include all persons who have completed the Pfizer, Moderna, and J & J prescribed vaccine protocol for at least 14 days. This masking exemption applies to all inside and outside activities currently enjoyed at Portage Yacht Club. Persons who have not completed one of the above protocols are required to wear masks and practice social distancing (8 feet at PYC).

One assumes this may influence a non-protocol vaccinated person who elects to go unmasked to avoid the stigma of not being vaccinated or not wishing to be vaccinated. Don't let that stigma get in your way, use common sense, the alternative could be getting sick or dying. And you vaccinated folks should not prejudge the teen and adult masked, they may be just exercising caution.

A Member is responsible and obligated to ensure their guests follow these instructions while on the PYC premises (Parking Lot, Park and Beach, Clubhouse Decks, and Marina).
