In an effort to put fewer race management assignments on crews, the race committee reviewed the participation in our series and determined that the present Gold series (weekend) racing was generating a lot of RM assignments but had low race participation. For this season we are going to concentrate on the Silver Series and suspend the Gold Series. This year's program will only offer racing on Thursday nights. As with last year, the Silver Servies is consolidated with all fleets racing on Thursday evenings.

For those racers who would like to compete on the weekends, we are working on organizing unofficial weekend racing (with self-management) when there is sufficient interest. There will be more information on that as we get closer to summer.
